

BC Regional Braille Challenge 2020
Foundational (Primary)
Charts and Graphs – Level 1, Part 1



Please encourage the student to complete the following without looking at his/her hands.

Orient the student to the spatial array. Ask them to show you the top, bottom, left and right sides of the page.

Instructions to the student: “We are going to explore this page of shapes. I am going to ask you some questions and I would like you to use the sticky balls to mark your answers when asked to do so.” [Students can use markers for all questions if that is helpful].

1. Find and mark the star. Hint: This is the only shape that has a solid fill. [1 star]
2. Find and count all the circles on the page. These circles are different sizes and some are empty and some are filled. [5 circles]
3. How many heart shapes are there on the page? Please mark them. [Feel free to give the student a description of the shape - one heart]
4. Count the number of small squares. Now count the number of large squares. Which are there more of on the page? [Same number]
5. Which shape is located at the very top left corner of the page? [Square]
6. Which shape is located at the very top right corner of the page? [Triangle]
7. Find all the other triangles on the page that are the same size. How many small triangles altogether? [3]
8. Find the hexagon. Which shape is to the right of the hexagon? [Square]
9. Which shape is closest to the bottom of the page? [Circle]
10. BONUS: How many special shapes are there on the page? These are shapes that only appear once. [Three]
