

# Calling all Teachers of Students with Visual Impairments!

If you have a student who reads and writes braille, they are eligible to participate in the Braille Challenge!



## What is the Braille Challenge?

The Braille Challenge is the only academic competition of its kind in North America for students who are blind or visually impaired. Any student in grades 1 – 12 who can read and write braille is eligible to participate.

All students can compete in the **Preliminary Braille Challenge**, which is held from January through March throughout the United States and Canada, but only the top 50 students with the highest scores qualify for **Braille Challenge Finals**.
